

Richard Pacher Award for exceptional publications in heart failure research

The Austrian, German, and Swiss Working Groups for Heart Failure are advertising the **Richard Pacher Award for exceptional publications in Heart Failure Research 2022**.

This award is endowed with € 4 000 and was awarded for the first time in 2017. Original scientific work accepted for publication in the years 2021 and 2022 can be submitted for consideration in the categories 'Clinical Science' or 'Basic Science' (each awarded with €2 000). The Award is conferred to leading authors (first-, last-, or corresponding author) who should be under the age of 45 at the submission deadline and are required to receive the Award in person at the *D-A-CH Dreiländertreffen Herzinsuffizienz* in Graz, Austria on October 8, 2022. The work has to be predominately done in Europe, i.e. more than 50% of authors must be affiliated with a European institution.

The aim of this award is to commemorate Richard Pacher by supporting exceptional or unconventional approaches to heart failure research. We are aware that this research will not necessarily be immediately recognized by high-ranking journals, thus judges will not predominantly judge impact and rank of the journal but merit of the work.
